

Harmonies either need to be cracked by repeatedly going over them or having the parts on the web site for members to practice at home. There's no hope that people will be able to remember harmonies if this does not happen and it is the harmonies that make a song interesting and enjoyable for an audience and rewarding for those singing. Rather than an extensive repertoire why not smaller with more chance of both choirs really learning the songs. There are 37 in the 2019 collection, far, far too many!
